Purpose: The purpose of the Emergency Action Plan (EAP) is to guide athletic and medical personnel in the response of a medical emergency.

Medical Equipment: First aid supply kits (gauze, prewrap, tape, ice packs, bandages), Blood Borne Pathogens Supplies (gloves, mask, alcohol pads), Automatic External Defibrillator (AED)

Lightnight Safe Locations: Athletic Training Room C120 or High School Gymnasium

PROCEDURE: The EAP should be initiated when a member on scene recognizes an emergent, serious or life threatening situation. If the athletic trainer isn't present the coach takes initial responsibility for emergency care.

- 1. Assess the situation and determine the need for further assistance, if necessary, designate someone to call to the **Local Millbury Dispatch Number: (1) 508-865-3521** or 911
- 2. The most experienced medical personnel on the scene identifies task of specific Emergency Response Team members (treating the victim, meeting EMS upon arrival, <u>have someone wait at G1 for ambulance and if blocked find another path</u>, secure the emergency scene, keep students/staff away from area, clear scene of all but essential personnel)
- 3. The athletic trainer or medical personnel will administer appropriate first aid procedures to the victim while they wait for EMS to arrive. CPR/AED protocols will be initiated if deemed necessary. AEDs are located:
 - On field- each coach should have their assigned AED at all practices and games
 - Central Office- (1) entry way
 - Millbury Jr./Sr. High School- (1)front hallway, near teacher's room and gym; (2) outside the Media center; (3) main lobby of the jr. high; (4) soon to be located on the second floor at the catwalk
- 4. Upon the arrival of EMS, a member of the Emergency Personnel will communicate all known details of the medical emergency and explain any specific treatment given to the victim. EMS shall take charge of the situation.
- 5. The victim's emergency contact information should be obtained by the coach, athletic trainer or the athletic director. Then a designated member of the Emergency Response Team will contact the person's parent/guardian/family member.
- 6. Consult with athletic trainer about filling out incident report
